Introductions

At the Sons & Daughters of Italy, C. Colombo Lodge #1315 (SOI) April 11, 2018 meeting, Louise Silacci, our Central State Trustee, joined us at the Antioch Senior Center. Louise reported on some highlights that are issues for this year's State convention:

- Membership has dropped below 4,000 in the state of California. In previous years, California membership was approximately 10,000 members state wide, the current membership is a huge decline.
- Three (3) lodges in California are close to losing their status:
 - Las Vegas
 - Lake County
 - o San Diego
- Credentials are being issued in June.
- A Trustee is needed for the Western Foundation.
- 2018 has been declared the year of Italian food.
 - If C. Colombo Lodge #1315 has a cookbook, bring it to the Convention for display.
- Louise is also requesting a change in the college verification process for a student who is a scholarship recipient. It's expensive for the student to provide transcripts so it would be more efficient and cost effective to go on-line at the student's college website to verify their student status.
- The SOI-California have transitioned to a new membership system. The system will go live at the end of May due to some issues getting it up and running. At the meeting, it was mentioned that no one was ever aware that there was a system change. The new system will be more efficient and will produce better membership reports.
- There will no longer be just a Queen for SOI of California, it will now be a Royal Court Pageant to include a Queen or King and everyone else running will be crowned a prince or princess.
